

- Numerous requests by Legislators, including audits of appropriations for the Alamo Complex, contracting at the Department of Information Resources, and procurement processes at the Health and Human Services Commission.

Additionally, she supervises and signs the auditor opinion for state agency financial statement audits, including the State of Texas Annual Comprehensive Financial Report.

Porter most recently served as Associate Vice Chancellor for governmental relations for the Texas Tech University System. He spent most of his career, from 1996 to 2014, serving as Chief of Staff for Texas State Senator Robert Duncan. In that role, Porter worked closely with ERS on legislation related to state employee benefits, demonstrating a strong commitment to ERS members and retirees, as well as keen knowledge of state government, benefits and budgets. Prior to leading

Duncan's Senate staff, Porter was his legislative assistant when he served in the Texas House of Representatives.

In his years in state government, Porter earned the respect of lawmakers, colleagues, and other associates. 
